

STATE GOLF YEAR LONG CHAMPIONSHIPS-INDIVIDUAL

We will have a year long competition to determine individual championships in addition to the one day State Individual Championship.

The competition will be over all Official State events, starting with the Spring Fling in Napa and ending with the final event in the Monterey Area November. Each Tournament (except the Team ABCD Scramble at Hiddenbrooke) will have at least one day where a player can record an individual score, such as 4 man 2 best ball or individual score competitions. A player may compete in as many events as he chooses, but the results will be his 3 best scores in that calendar year. He must putt out all holes for his score to be eligible. Scrambles are NOT eligible.

Example: Player A plays Napa, Reno, Rancho Solano, BlackHorse and State Individual Championship. His net scores are 72,70, 75, 75 and 68. His score will be $68+70+72$ or 210. Player B only plays 3 times scoring net 67,76 and 71. His score would be the sum of the 3 or 214.

The idea is to keep player interest in the program and increase participation throughout the season.

We would have 3 flights—they would be fixed based on the Index a player has at the first event he plays in. For instance a players Index could be April 1 24.2, May 1 23.9, June 24.6. If the first tournament he plays is Napa in April, he would have a 24.2 for the purpose of placement in a flight. However, his score in each tournament would be based on the actual handicap used for that tournament.

The 3 flights will be 0-20, 20.1 to 30, 30.1 and above.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS—TEAMS

There will also be a year long Team competition. The 3 best net scores will be used for each Team. There will be numerous chances for Teams to compete in 4 man 2 Best Ball events during the year.

A Team will consist of a minimum of 4 players and a maximum of 6. Players may only compete for one team during the season. Alternate players on a Team may play in tournaments on other Teams, but those Teams may not post their scores for this competition if they use a player not on their roster.

Teams should be registered before playing in one of the following ways:

1. E-mail or letter to State Golf Chairman before the first event they participate in
2. Sign up on the day of the event BEFORE they tee off. The check in table will accept Team registrations.
3. CLEARLY indicate on your entry form that you are forming a Team for the Championship.

Players may be transferred from one Team to another in the following cases:

1. They have not yet played on the Team they originally registered with
2. If they have played for a Team, they may transfer to another Team if the original Team withdraws their score for that competition. (ie, the Player technically would not have played on a Team in competition).

EXAMPLES:

Jack plays for Team Stockton at Eagle Vines, but wants to change Teams. If Team Stockton agrees to let him transfer to another Team, their score at EV will not be counted.

Fred is on Team Tahoe but has not yet played in one of the competitions with his Team. He wishes to move to a new Team. This is OK since he did not play for Team Tahoe yet.

Team Vallejo has 6 players and all have played, but 3 are injured and they wish to play BlackHorse/Bayonet in November. They have already posted 3 scores. In this case, they may not add a player. If they had only played 1 or 2 times, then a substitute player may be added (as long as he has not played for another Team OR the other Team releases him).

Two players from Team Stockton and 2 players from Team San Jose have not yet played for their Teams and wish to form a new Team. This is OK, since

none of them had played for another Team. However, if one had played for his former Team, he could be released if the score for that event is dropped.

A Team may be formed and compete at any time during the season as long as there are 3 remaining tournaments to play.

STANDINGS:

After each Tournament is concluded, the Team Standings will be published on the website.

SCRAMBLES—Scrambles are NOT eligible for posting scores. Only 4 man 2 Best Ball tournament scores are eligible.

COST: THERE IS NO ADDITIONAL COST FOR PARTICIPATING IN EITHER OF THESE CHAMPIONSHIPS!!

PRIZES: There will be significant cash prizes for the top finishers.
