Exciting News from the State SIRS...

March 1, 2019

As announced at the Feb. 12 Big Sir/Little Sir Town Hall Meeting and the Feb. 13 Regional Director/Area Governor Meeting, a new SIR Manual is replacing the existing SIR Rules Manual. The SIR Manual is now on the Member Information page of the <u>sirinc.org</u> website- found under "STATE INFORMATION, then "Key Documents", then "SIR Manual" (You can also click on the link below).

The principal revision is an overhaul of the 400 Standing Rules into 50 Policies and Procedures (P&P) approved by the State Board in January. The review process included:

- Simplification, consolidation, and removal of obsolete wording.
- Inclusion of Bylaw policies that were not already summarized in existing Rules.
- Transfer of position-related duties to updated or new Position Descriptions (15+ Branch and 10 State positions). These 2/28/19 updates will be found also on the Member Information page of the <u>sirinc.org</u> website- under STATE INFORMATION "SIR Position Descriptions" within a few days.

The Schedule of Operations (Branch and State) also will be on the SIRinc website shortly, with a 2/27/19 revision date. For Branches, please use the updated Schedule for your BEC monthly meeting agendas. Other documents including State Forms are also being revised to delete any obsolete rule numbers.

Kelly Siefkin Biography

Kelly Siefkin is the VP of Communications & Marketing for Sacramento Food Bank & Family Services (SFBFS). Kelly joined SFBFS as the Volunteer Manager in 2007 and transitioned into communication and fund development in 2009. Kelly works to establish messaging for the organization through the media, the organization's Web site, speaking engagements, donor relationships, client outreach, volunteer training and social media.

One of Kelly's greatest achievements is helping orchestrate Run to Feed the Hungry, the largest Thanksgiving Day fun run in the country, with 27,169 participants in 2018.

In 2008, Kelly received the Volunteer Spirit Award for Volunteer Coordinator of the Year in Sacramento County, Kelly previously worked as the Program Coordinator and Volunteer Coordinator for United Animal Nations, training and deploying volunteers to shelter animals in the aftermath of disasters for four years.

Prior to working at these two non-profit organizations, Kelly spent a year serving as a member of AmeriCorps National Civilian Community Corps. Service projects included tutoring children in Colorado, cutting trail in Southern Catifornia, assisting seniors on Indian reservations in Arizona and building homes in Idaho.

In 2016, Kelly earned her CFRE, Certified Fundraising Executive Certification, and was named a 40 Under 40 for by the Sacramento Business Journal. Kelly currently serves on the board for the local chapter of the Association of Fundraising professionals and recently completed her second term as chapter President. Kelly also serves as a board member for the California 4-H Foundation

Kelly holds a bachelor's degree from UC Davis in Human Development and a master's degree in Organizational Leadership from Chapman University.


