2020 SIR 93 Annual Dues

David Saxby, the SIR 93 Branch Treasurer, will be at February 17th Meal Sign-up Table to collect the \$20.00 Annual Membership Dues.

The collection of the Annual Dues Payments is important for the survival of the SIR 93 Branch so we can meet the branch's financial obligations.

Words of Wisdom and Hello from SIR 93 Golf

The World Handicap System has started up in 2020 with a big learning curve for the SIR 93

Club Handicapper (Connor Chin) and the posting of the personal score (tournament scores will

still be posted by the SIR 93 Club Handicapper).

The big replacement / change is that the ESC Adjustment will no longer be used in WHS.

Instead we will need to use the Net Double Bogey Rule for all adjustments to your Gross Score.

An example would be for a 20 Handicap Golfer, there will be two holes where the golfer would

have two stroke handicap deduction. So if Hole #1 Rated Par was 4, the player's score was 9,

and deduct the 2 stroke Handicap calculation to get a net score of 7.

This player would need to take a one stroke deduction on his gross score because the player

exceeded the net double bogey limitation.

For posting of your personal scores, please use the Total Score Tab / Option instead of the

Hole-by-Hole Method (it is not totally in operation yet for all courses). The **Adjusted Gross**

Score can be entered by either Front Nine plus Back Nine or just entered in the Adjusted Total

Score as one entry in the Total Score Area.

Please remember that your handicap calculation takes place at 12:00 Midnight (Eastern Time)

every evening so it is important to post your "correct adjusted gross score" on the day that it

was played.

Also, WHS is now using the best 8 out of your last 20 rounds at 100% calculation of your best

eight posted scores average. Previously, it was best 10 out of your last 20 rounds at a 96%

calculation.
