BEC Members Present:

Bob L. suggested that the membership receive a warning about the potential penalty, but that enforcement be postponed until we try the evite system. The BEC agreed. (7) Jack R. suggested that we participate in a Farmers Market held at Elks Lodge from 9am to 1pm on Saturdays. He would purchase a table covering with our name on it, and flyers, as a means of advertising for new members. We would need at least six volunteers to staff the table. (8) Jack R. proposed that we replace our Breakfast Together activity with a Burger lunch on the Monday following our regular meeting date, and perhaps doing it at Buckhorn on Freeport Boulevard. He suggested that we start on Monday April 22nd. The BEC agreed to try the Burger lunch.
